

SCHOOL UNIFORM

REGULAR UNIFORM:

- Students must wear their uniform with pride and ensure that they look neat, tidy and presentable at all times.
- The school uniform should be worn on all working days and for all school functions including all such instances where students are representing the school outside.
- Students coming to school even on an off day or PTM must come in regular school uniform.
- Each student is supposed to carry a clean, ironed, handkerchief to school every day without fail.
- It is a must for all girls from classes LKG to X to wear long white slips.
- Bloomers (with elastic on thighs) preferably in skin colour/beige colour are compulsory for girls from classes LKG to III.
- Underskirts/tights preferably in skin colour/beige colour are mandatory for girls from classes IV to X.
- Students who are slovenly dressed or not in uniform will be sent home.
- No alteration regarding length and pattern.

SPORTS (PE) UNIFORM:

• Sports Uniform is prescribed to be worn only when the students have PE Periods or sports activity slated in the schedule for that particular day. Students are not supposed to wear Sports Uniform on days of examination/school functions.

HAIR:

- Boys must keep their hair short and no fancy haircut. Beards not allowed.
- Girl's hair to be plaited in two and tied neatly with ribbon/band Colors of ribbon/band/clip for LKG and UKG Yellow; I-X Bottle green for Regular Uniform and House colour for Sports (PE) uniform.
- Colouring, bleaching or highlighting of hair is not permitted.

- Please monitor the internet sites being visited by your ward and limit the TV viewing to appropriate programs.
- Please inform the school about any change of residence/telephone number to facilitate contact.
- Please cooperate with the school by paying attention to your ward's regularity, punctuality and discipline and by taking interest in his/her work.
- Do check the bag of your ward from time to time.
- Any communication made by you should be addressed to the Principal and not to the class teacher.
- Use of mobile by parents in the school campus is strictly prohibited.
- No cash should be sent with students unless informed by school.
- Respect the internal policies of school; all the policies are binding on parents. No discussion in this regard will be entertained.
- Lunch box/pack shall be carried by the student to school on a daily basis. Fruits /breakfast/porridge is to be encouraged in the tiffins.
- No items such as food, water bottles, books, school bag, projects will be accepted at the gates and sent to the students once they come to school.
- No bouquets and cakes will be allowed in school premises for any kind of celebration.
- Prior permission must be obtained to meet the Principal/Vice Principal/teachers unless it is an emergency.

LATE ARRIVALS IN SCHOOL

- The school gate will close at 7:50 am sharp.
- Students are expected to reach school atleast 10 minutes before the start of the first period (start of the school).
- Late arrivals will be sent home immediately.
- Action will be taken against two late arrivals in a month and who are not carrying the Almanac.

SQUAD/HOUSE SYSTEM

- The students are divided into six houses named after prominent Indian rivers Chenab, Ganges, Jhelum, Ravi, Sutlej & Yamuna.
- Inter-house cultural and sports events are held through the year to promote talent and foster team spirit among house members.

- Parents, who require fee receipt to claim fee reimbursement or for Income tax purpose are advised to pay through the <u>school fee challan</u> only.
- After making the payment through online kindly inform the school office by sending an email of the transaction at dpsmgl@gmail.com. Kindly mention the student's name, class and section in the email.

WITHDRAWALNORMS

- If a child has to be withdrawn from school, parents are requested to give one calendar months' notice in writing, failing which, one month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof. Exception may be made in case of sudden transfer of government or military personnel. No oral communication to Class Teacher/Office shall be considered.
- Students who take TC after 31st March will have to pay the Annual Fee for the next session and tuition fee till the month, on which TC application is received.
- TC will not be issued until all the school dues are settled.
- TC will be issued only to parents or authorized persons and letter from the school where admission is sought is mandatory to issue TC.
- Readmission on TC cancellation shall then be made strictly on availability of seats and have to pay admission fee including all other fees in a single installment.

SCHOOL FEE 2024-25

- 1. It is the responsibility of the parents to pay the dues on or before due date.
- 2. Full payment in one installment is also accepted; but should be done on or before 1st June 2024.
- 3. School fee is collected for a period of 12 months even if the child joins school in between the academic year.
- 4. a. School fee can be paid in four installments, breakup of which will be intimated by the school.

- b. In case that a due date coincides with a holiday or with an event or function held by the School, parents should make arrangements to pay the outstanding balance in advance or they can pay the due through NEFT, GPay or any other UPI modes.

- d. After making the payment through NEFT, IMPS, GPAY or any UPI mode kindly inform the school office by mailing the transaction details to dpsmgl@gmail.com (mandatory).
- e. All cheques are subject to realization on or before the due date of the school fee and the realization date will be considered for the issuance of a receipt. Therefore, parents who are paying with cheque must ensure that the cheque clearance date should be on or before the due date failing which penalty will be charged.
- 5 In case of default, Rs.15 per day will be charged as penalty till the due is cleared. The fee defaulter's name will be struck off from the rolls after one month of last date of payment due and the same is the responsibility of the parents.
- 6. Re-admission shall then be made strictly on availability of seats and is upto the discretion of the school management and binding on the parents.
- 7. Payment of fees in installments is a facility for the existing students of the school. This facility is not applicable for new admissions.
- 8. In case of any queries parents can contact the class teachers by giving prior intimation through Almanac.

PARENT-TEACHER INTERACTION

- Parents are advised to check ERP regularly.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Half day leave:

Half day leave is not permitted. However, in case of emergency leave can be obtained with the permission of the Principal after completing formalities.

Planned Leave:

- Parents are requested to send a leave application in advance in case of planned leave.
- Parents should fill the Leave application (Planned leave) section of the Almanac if the planned leave not more than 3 days and take approval from Vice Principal

Unplanned Leave:

- Absence from school for more than 5 consecutive days is not allowed, except on medical grounds, subject to information provided beforehand.
- A student who has been absent on the previous day will not be allowed to attend class unless the 'Record of Non-attendance' section of the Almanac filled by the parent/guardian.
- In case a child reports to school after absence without an explanation in the Almanac, the parents will be called to school and the child will be sent back home.
- In case of absence for more than 3 days on medical grounds, Medical Certificate and Prescription (photocopies) should be attached along with the leave application.
- Repeated absence without notice or unexplained absence without written application for more than six consecutive days renders the student liable to have her/his name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may only be granted after approval by the Head of School and payment of a prescribed re-admission fee.
- A student returning to school after suffering from an infection or contagious disease must provide a doctor's certificate permitting him/her to attend school. A student suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.

Whooping cough – six weeks.

COVID 19-a fortnight.


