

- 5. Fee rebate: Besides, those who pay full fee on or before 1st June 2025 will be given 2% of total fee as an early payment before. Those who have paid the school fee in full by 01 June 2025, are requested to submit an application for claiming the said rebate, indication the Bank account de tails along with copy of front page of passbook / copy of cancelled cheque in support of account details.

- c. The school is providing the facility of M-swipe scanner payment at school office.
- d. All cheques are subject to realization on or before the due date of the school fee and the realization date will be considered for the issuance of a receipt. Therefore, parents who are paying with cheque must ensure that the cheque clearance date should be on or before the due date failing which penalty will be charged.
- 7. Penalty: In case of default, Rs.15 per day will be charged as penalty till the due is cleared. The fee defaulter's name will be struck off from the rolls after one month of last date of payment due and the same is the responsibility of the parents.
- 8. Re-admission shall then be made strictly on availability of seats and is upto the discretion of the school management and is binding on the parents.

- 3. In the morning as pupils come to school, they should sit in their respective classes and spend the time reviewing the days activities as per timetable



- d. All cheques are subject to realization on or before the due date of the school fee and the realization date will be considered for the issuance of a receipt. Therefore, parents who are paying with cheque must ensure that the cheque clearance date should be on or before the due date failing which penalty will be charged.
- 7. Penalty: In case of default, Rs.15 per day will be charged as penalty till the due is cleared. The fee defaulter's name will be struck off from the rolls after one month of last date of payment due and the same is the responsibility of the parents.
- Re-admission shall then be made strictly on availability of seats and is upto the discretion of the school management and is binding on the parents.
- In case of any queries parents can contact the class teachers by giving prior intimation through Almanac.
- 10. The school almanac makes it very clear that TC applications must be submitted by 31 March 2025, and that any student leaving the institution after 01 April 2025, must submit a written application to the school regarding the discontinuation. Therefore, fees must be paid up until the TC application is received. No oral communication in this regard will be entertained/considered.


