A sapling was planted, reaffirming our commitment to protecting and preserving the environment.

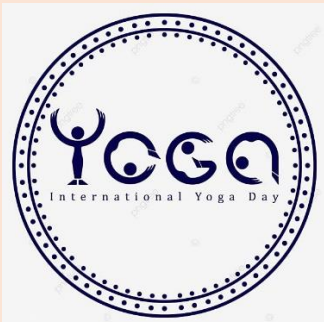
