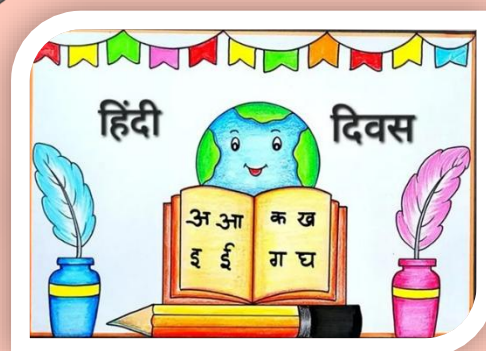
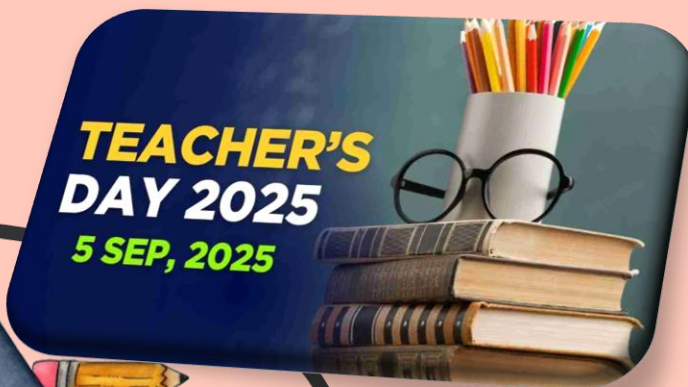
AICS D.K Inter-School Chess Tournament
