The day began with fun-filled activities such as leaf printing, paper tearing and pasting, and colouring green objects.






Raising the National Cadet Corps - Naval Unit








Capacity Building Programme on "Promoting Health and Wellness among Students" was organized on 12 September 2025 at Delhi Public School, Mangalore. The


